ECONOMIC IMPACT

- In 2012, California's craft breweries generated approximately \$4.7 billion in total economic impact in California.
- Today, there are more than 450 craft breweries in California and that number is growing.

JOBS

- California's craft brewers as small and independently owned businesses – support <u>44,000 jobs</u> in a state where unemployment is still recovering.
- One job is created for every 100 barrels of craft beer brewed in California.
- The average salary for an employee in the brewing industry is more than \$38,000 a year.

PRODUCTION

- The craft brewing industry in increased its production by 21% 2012.
- One in every five craft beers in the United States is brewed in California.

TAXES

• As small and independently owned businesses, California's craft breweries paid more than \$850 million in total local, state and federal taxes in 2012.

GROWTH

 Nationwide the craft brewing industry grew 15% by production and 17% by dollars in 2012 compared to 2011.
